With the holy touch of eight sikh gurus, historical place khadur sahib is famous all around the world as the pious land of Shri Guru Angad Dev Ji. Shri Guru Nanak Dev ji came to this sacred place for five times during his preaching. Guru Angad dev ji spent almost 13 years of guruship in Khadur Sahib and accomplished many tasks such as modifying Gurumukhi script and started Langar system to eliminate the caste system. 'Mall Akhada' was establish to keep youngsters away from bad habits and make them physically fit. On this very place Shri Guru Angad Dev ji Blessed guruship to Shri Guru Amardass Ji and endowered him with grace. Baba Budha and Bhai Gurdass Ji, dedicated devotee of guru ji visited Khadur sahib time to time.

### **Environment protection campaign:**

In materialistic era, today's mortal is cutting trees blindly for his self motives. Hence, environmental pollution has been rapidly increased and is increasing. Baba Sewa singh ji, Chief of Kar Sewa Khadur sahib has taken appropriate steps to make environment clean. #### Nishan – E – Sikhi International School

Keeping in mind academic facility of native residence, Nishan - E- Sikhi international school established under the guidance of Baba Sewa singh ji, S. Kartar Singh Thakral with the special contribution of surrounding sangat. The school is running under Nishan - E - Sikhi Charitable trust. The school is affiliated to Delhi upto Secondary Level and constructed with modern infrastructure, the school is occupying the area of almost 6 acres. The building of the school is constructed on the basics of historical sikh architecture and latest technology has been used.

At present fourth academic session is going on. Total 1337 students are getting education from class Nursery to class 11<sup>th</sup>. The school provides many modern facilities such as modern computer lab, physics lab, chemistry lab, social science lab, smart classes, activity room, Library laid with the modern facilities and big playground. Our school is always determined to bring out inner talent of students and polishing their skills. Music department has been founded to give bright shape to musical interest and training of the students. Students are provided the training of Gurmat and folk music in the music room. Moreover, Art room has been arranged to bring out artistic skill of students. To ensure the international standard of study, well qualified and experienced staff has been recruited.

## **Academic aspect**

With the infinite blessings of almighty, hard work of staff and true dedication of students, this institution affiliated to CBSE is providing high standard education. In academic session 2018-19, nineteen students of our school appeared in class 10<sup>th</sup> CBSE board. Examination result was marvellous. Setting golden journey from academic development to its input, the result of the first batch of the school was 100%. Kiranjot kaur got first position in school scoring 95.6% marks followed by Ajaypal singh bagging second position with 93.8% marks, Navdeep kaur third postion with 93% marks and Navpreet Kaur fourth position with 91.8% marks. In the delightment of good results and to encourage the students, Baba Sewa singh ji honoured the students with wrist watch and symbol of honour.

In addition to this, Ex- director of corporate and finance( The Indian Express group) gave a cheque of amount 45,000 rupees to motivate the students scored above 90% marks in CBSE board examination. Out of this amount a cheque of worth rupees 15,000 was given to First position holder Kiranjot kaur. Ajaypal singh, Navdeep kaur and Navpreet kaur were given the cheque of 10,000 rupees respectively. In the same way, S. Kulbir Singh Dhatta, Member of School managing committee presented a cheque of 40,000 rupees to the above mentioned students.

Similarly, Students performed well in mathematics, English, science exams being conducted by Science Olympiad foundation.

In Math Olympiad Harsimran Singh class 3<sup>rd</sup> A, Rippendeep singh class 4<sup>th</sup> B, Harshdeep Singh class 5<sup>th</sup> C, Manmeet Kaur class 6<sup>th</sup> B, Sharanjeet Kaur class 7<sup>th</sup> A, Karanjit Singh class 7<sup>th</sup> C got gold medals and Jasmeen Kaur 5<sup>th</sup> C, Navneet Kaur 6<sup>th</sup> B, Gurjant singh 8<sup>th</sup> C bagged silver medals. Mohpreet kaur 5<sup>th</sup> C, Gursher singh 6<sup>th</sup> B and Khushpreet kaur 8<sup>th</sup> C got bronze medals. In English Olympiad, Eveleen kaur 4<sup>th</sup> B, Harsimran Kaur 6<sup>th</sup> B, Kirandeep kaur 8<sup>th</sup> C, Harleen kaur 9<sup>th</sup> B got gold medals. Arpanpreet Kaur 7<sup>th</sup> A bagged gold medal in second level. Khushdeep kaur 7<sup>th</sup> A got silver and Khushi class 8<sup>th</sup> A got bronze medal in English Olympiad. In science Olympiad, Students of 8<sup>th</sup> C got gold medals.

In the same way, school's math mistress Miss Navpreet Kaur's model was selected for her excellence performance in Teachers Teaching Aid Competition on regional level. This competition was held at Guru Nanak Public School Ludhiana and our school's entry was in mathematics.

It is the matter of proud for school that this model was also selected for the National Level. National Level competition was organized at Bharti vidya Bhawan Mehta vidayala, at New Delhi and in this competition, our school performance was commendable

# **Composition of Literary life:**

Co Curricular Activities:-After getting highest achievements in academic our students actively participated in the different activities conducted by the CBSE and other institutions. Similarly our students participated in the Religious Education Competition conducted by SGPC. Students from 6th-9th Grades took part in level 1. From which eight students of the school named Amitojbir Kaur of 8th Gurleen Kaur Husanpreet Singh, Gurleen Kaur,S imranpreet Kaur, Karandeep Singh, Sehajpreet Kaur, Sejalpreet Kaur of 9th got merit position in this competition and got rupees 1100 as a scholarship. Similarly in level 2, students of 10th participated and Kirpal Singh, Vipindeep Kaur Jasdeep Kaur Navpreet Kaur got merit positions and were awarded with rupees 2100 scholarship .On the occasion of birthday of Shri Guru Angad Dev Ji "Gurbani Kanth Competition" was organised at Bhai Jodh Singh hall khadur Sahib. In which Mankaran Singh of 9th got second position and cash prize of rupees 1000.

Moreover, on the occasion of 550th birthday of Guru Nanak Dev Ji, in declamation competition which was organised at Gurudwara Guru Nanak Padhao Fatehabad, Kirpal Singh got second position .In a competition organised by The Millennium

School Amritsar titled "The Millennium challenge 2019" our students participated in debate and PPT presentation. In this competition, 25 schools participated and among those our students Amritpreet Singh and Kirpal Singh proved their best and got the reward of "Speaker of Excellence".

Similarly in a competition organised by SGPC in favour to Guru Ramdas ji birthday at Gurdwara Manji Sahib ,our 9th Grade students Mankaran Singh, Gurkanwal preet Singh and 10th grade's students Jaspreet Singh ,Navpreet Kaur ,Jaismeen Kaur got second prize in writing competition and in kavishri competition, Husanpreet Singh' Armaandeep Singh of 9th and Amrajpreet Singh of 10th got third position. Similarly in Amritsar Public School, a competition dedicated to Guru Nanak Dev Ji 550th birthday, inter school declamation competition was organised in which our 10th class student Kirpal Singh got consolation prize.

Achievements in sports:-keeping in mind the value of games, a special attention was paid by the school management towards sports. School provides sports as athletics, basketball, volleyball, badminton ,Kho -Kho etc to the students. Games plays an important role in the intellectual development of the students. So keeping this view in mind and to promote the intellectual level of the students, an Indoor Games Room was framed ,in which table tennis, carrom board ,chess etc games are being played by the students. Students are also sent for inter school sports competition i.e. 65th zonal sports 2019-20 conducted by the government Senior Secondary School Miyanwind .It is really a matter of proud that Harmandeep Singh of 10th A and Jasmanjeet Singh of 10th B, Ramneek Singh of 9th c and Ranjot Singh of 6th A are selected for the district level . Similarly in volleyball competition, our school team got second position at zonal level. In which Gursharanjit Singh of 9th b , Gurtaj Singh of 10th A ,Jaskarandeep Singh of 10th A, Sahib Preet Singh of 7th B are selected for the district level . School team also got first position in Table Tennis and a student of 10th A Amrit Preet Singh was selected for district level.

So in this way selected students' journey of sports has been admirable. To promote the spirit of sports in students' mind and Heart ,School organised an Annual Athletics Meet. Students run a race of 50m,60m ,100m 200m,400 m 800m and participated in long jump discus throw, shot put, relay etc .By showing highest valued spirit, these students got 44 gold medals, 43 silver medals and 44 bronze medals.Among boys JasKaran Singh of 10th and among girls Ripandeep Kaur of 10 A were chosen best athletes.In this competition Hari Singh Nalwa house stood first, Baba Deep Singh house stood second and Akali Phoola Singh house stood third.

National and international days:-School also celebrates National and international days related to different subject. With this view water day, teacher's day, World language Day, Earth Day, Sparrow day etc. were also celebrated in the school. The world mother tongue day was celebrated by organising an awareness march. In this Awareness March, students reached Tapyana Sahib by holding self-made banners

and slogans .Students also raised voice to respect the mother tongue Punjabi and made the people aware about the importance of mother tongue.

Similarly School also organised a rally of students in favour of the Earth day. This really was started under the guidance of Sardar Charanjit Singh Ji, Deputy Director of Punjab Pollution Control Board. Students also raised Voice with slogans written on the the small wooden frames. Students also painted the trees which came in their way during the rally .The students also gave speeches in favour of the Earth Day. This rally reached at Gurudwara Shri Mal Akhada Sahib after passing many streets of khadur Sahib. This awareness March gave us the message to reduce the pollution on the earth.

Similarly World Sparrow day was also celebrated in the school. The Sparrow project was prepared by the students just to show the decreasing level of sparrows. It took 10 days to the students to prepare this project. In this project nests were prepared with the scrap sheets and given the shape of a triangle. Students also fixed these Nests in their houses.

Inter house competitions:-To build up the internal spirit and to promote physical and moral level of the students, School formed four houses that is Baba Deep Singh Ji, Akali Phoola Singh Ji, Sardar Hari Singh Nalwa and Sardar Shyam Singh Atari. In these houses competitions such as declamation ,debate, poem recitation ,calligraphy ,Turban tying , painting competitions are organised for juniors as well as seniors .These houses not only build up artistic and creative values but also make them disciplined ,dedicated and give them a sense of obligation,

Direction to moral life:-The school not only provides education of Information and Technology but also gives the religious education of rich heritage of Sikhs. Keeping this main aim in mind ,the school also celebrates birthday, martyrdom day, first Prakash Divas of Guru Granth Sahib Ji. The school also celebrated 550th birthday of Guru Nanak Dev Ji and inter house competition related to Guru ji's life like declamation ,quiz competition were also planned. The aim of organising these competitions is to relate students with religious facts and moral life.
